Why this wage:

- Role supports stucco and EIFS crews at heights on scaffolding and requires reliability under early-morning, multi-site conditions.
- Safety and productivity requirements are higher than general labour: fall protection and WHMIS are required or must be obtained on hire.
- Current local market for experienced stucco labour support warrants this rate to retain crews and meet contract timelines.

Core duties:

- Site preparation and protection, debris removal, and material staging.
- Scaffold assembly and teardown under supervision.
- Mixing stucco and EIFS materials to specification.
- Pump and hoist support, loading and unloading materials and equipment.
- Masking and surface protection, general site cleanup to handover standard.





- Basic tool handling associated with assisting stucco trades, without performing finishing work.

Requirements:

- No formal education required. On-the-job training provided.
- Valid BC driver's licence and certifications such as Fall Protection, WHMIS, and OFA-1 are assets.
- Full-time availability and willingness to travel to multiple sites.
